Needs Your Help!


The Holidays are over, but... The need is still there! Your donations allow us to keep our shelves stocked.



Gospel Meditation:

Once I was at a meeting with representatives of various religions. On a coffee break, a man from another religion mused to me: "You know, with all our differences, all religions are really about being good people."

I lowered my cappuccino and said as warmly as I could, "That's not what mine's about."

His look begged for clarification. I said, "Mine is about plunging into the life of God."

Just before Jesus ascended into heaven, he commanded the eleven apostles, "Go, therefore, and make disciples of all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father, and of the Son, and of the Holy Spirit, teaching them to observe all that I have commanded you; and behold, I am with you always, until the end of the age." (Matthew 28:19-20).

The word "baptize" means "to immerse in, to plunge into." It presupposes the use of water.

But what does it mean to be immersed in God's name? In the Bible, God's name is identical to God Himself.

So, to be baptized into water, using Jesus' formula, is to be plunged into the life of God.

Said another way, it is to die with Jesus and rise with him as a member of his body.

The Trinity isn't a doctrine simply to accept and ponder.

It's more like an ocean: a mystery into which we are baptized... inserted, immersed, dunked, plunged.

Baptism gives us power to live our lives as beloved children of God, patterned after Jesus himself, who is always with us, until the end of the ages. Hardly the same as being good people. Stranger, but much better.

Meditación del Evangelio:

Una vez estuve en una reunión con representantes de varias religiones. En una pausa para el café, un hombre de otra religión me dijo: "Sabes, con todas nuestras diferencias, todas las religiones se tratan realmente de ser buenas personas". Bajé mi capuchino y dije tan cálidamente como pude: "De eso no se trata el mío". Su mirada pedía una aclaración. Le dije, "La mía es sumergirse en la vida de Dios".

Justo antes de que Jesús ascienda al cielo, ordena a los once apóstoles: "Id, pues, y haced discípulos a todas las naciones, bautizándolos en el nombre del Padre, y del Hijo, y del Espíritu Santo, enseñándoles a guardar todo lo que os he mandado; y he aquí, yo estoy con vosotros todos los días, hasta el fin del mundo". (Mateo 28:19-20).

La palabra "bautizar" significa "sumergirse en, sumergirse en". Presupone el uso del agua.

Pero, ¿qué significa estar inmerso en el nombre de Dios? En la Biblia, el nombre de Dios es idéntico al de Dios mismo. Por lo tanto, ser bautizado en agua, usando la fórmula de Jesús, es sumergirse en la vida de Dios. Dicho de otra manera, es morir con Jesús y resucitar con él como miembro de su cuerpo.

La Trinidad no es una doctrina simplemente para aceptar y reflexionar.

Es más bien un océano: un misterio en el que somos bautizados... insertado, sumergido, sumergido, sumergido.

El bautismo nos da el poder de vivir nuestras vidas como hijos amados de Dios, siguiendo el modelo de Jesús mismo, que siempre está con nosotros, hasta el fin de los tiempos.

No es lo mismo que ser buenas personas. Más extraño, pero mucho mejor.

MEMORIAL DAY - May 27

A lot of people ask about the upcoming civil holiday... Monday - Memorial Day.

Why is everything closed? What's the big deal? "What's the difference between *Memorial Day* and *Veterans Day*? Aren't they the same?" Once again... that's one of those "yes-and-no" answers that I love so much!

Both honor veterans and all veterans are honored on Veterans day...

But, not all veterans are honored on Memorial Day. That sounds more complicated than it is.

First, we have to define exactly what a veteran (*Vet*) is. A veteran is someone who has served in the armed forces and was discharged under other than dishonorable conditions. Current military members are considered to be Veterans.

So... Being a Vet is a great thing... Thank you all for your service to our country, and us!

Most people don't stop an think that each and every Vet... when they signed their name to their enlistment papers and took their oath of allegiance... were putting their life on the line in defense of our country... in defense of you and me! I don't care what kind of job they held in the military... whether it was front-line combat, medical, supply-clerk, company-clerk, or whatever... first and foremost all vets were trained in combat and were 'on the line' for duty!

Veterans Day was originally known as *Armistice Day* - to commemorate the end of World War I. It's a federal holiday observed annually on November 11, for honoring *all* military veterans.

Memorial Day, on the other hand, is an American holiday, observed on the last Monday of May, honoring the men and women who *died* while serving in the U.S. military.

Memorial Day originally honored those lost while fighting in the Civil War. But the United States found itself embroiled in other major conflicts, and the holiday evolved to commemorate all who died in war.

Know a Vet? Thank them... thank their family (sometimes it's actually more difficult for those left behind). Buy her / him a cup of coffee.
