# Gospel Meditation:

Maggots, grubs, worms. When I imagine one or many of these nasty slimy buggers living inside my body — unseen, feeding off my flesh, slowly rotting me out — I feel deeply disgusted. If I knew I had a worm, I would do anything to remove the alien invader, and fast. But what if I couldn't ever get it out?

This is precisely the image Jesus uses to describe those who cause others to sin and fail to cut out what leads them to sin. He contrasts the kingdom of God with Gehenna, "where the worm does not die."

If we can stomach it for a moment, there is much wisdom in this nauseating metaphor.

*First*, sin is always parasitic. It feeds on what is good like a worm in a host.

It's not symbiotic or additive, as virtue and love always are. Sin invades, devours, and damages the sinner. **Second**, sin is always social. No matter how hidden, it quietly eats away at others — usually the most poor and vulnerable, the "little ones," as the Lord says. How healthy it is for us to acknowledge this! Our gossiping, greed, over-indulgence, lying, pride, laziness, lust for power and reputation, and so on ... they do not add anything to life. They are worms eating away at others and ourselves.

We cut out these filthy parasites through genuine repentance and bold action. Imagine the peace and relief that follows the removal of a sickening worm from your body. How much greater is the peace we enjoy when the spiritual worms are gone for good. We'd never wait to act against physical parasites. Neither should we with the worms of sin.

# Meditación del Evangelio:

Gusanos, larvas, gusanos. Cuando me imagino a uno o varios de estos desagradables y viscosos bichos viviendo dentro de mi cuerpo, invisibles, alimentándose de mi carne, pudriéndome lentamente, me siento profundamente asqueado. Si supiera que tengo un gusano, haría cualquier cosa para eliminar al invasor alienígena, y rápido. Pero, ¿qué pasaría si nunca pudiera sacarlo?

Esta es precisamente la imagen que Jesús usa para describir a aquellos que hacen pecar a otros y no logran eliminar lo que los lleva a pecar. Contrasta el reino de Dios con el Gehena, "donde el gusano no muere". Si podemos soportarlo por un momento, hay mucha sabiduría en esta metáfora nauseabunda.

*En primer lugar*, el pecado es siempre parasitario. Se alimenta de lo que es bueno, como un gusano en un huésped. No es simbiótico ni aditivo, como siempre lo son la virtud y el amor.

El pecado invade, devora y daña al pecador.

*En segundo lugar*, el pecado es siempre social. No importa cuán escondido esté, en silencio carcome a los demás, generalmente a los más pobres y vulnerables, los "pequeños", como dice el Señor.

¡Qué saludable es para nosotros reconocer esto! Nuestros chismes, codicia, indulgencia excesiva, mentiras, orgullo, pereza, ansia de poder y reputación, etc. no añaden nada a la vida. Son gusanos que carcomen a los demás y a nosotros mismos.

Eliminamos estos parásitos inmundos mediante un arrepentimiento genuino y una acción audaz. Imagínese la paz y el alivio que sigue a la eliminación de un gusano repugnante de su cuerpo. ¡Cuánto mayor es la paz que disfrutamos cuando los gusanos espirituales se han ido para siempre! Nunca esperaríamos para actuar contra los parásitos físicos. Tampoco deberíamos hacerlo con los gusanos del pecado.



**Observation:** There seems to be a lot of division in some Christian churches over moral issues, especially abortion, contraception, ordination, and end-of-life care.

If all Christians follow the Gospel of Jesus, why is there such a difference of opinion?

**Response:** There is always a struggle between culture and religion, and part of that struggle is politics.

To be *politically correct* means that you must embrace the secular virtue of the moment so that you are "*enlightened*," "*sensitive*," "*aware*," and, most importantly, "*open-minded*."

Unfortunately, common sense can be sacrificed in the race to be "PC."

Some factions within Christian denominations have tried to redefine tradition, history, and biblical teaching to bend it around the *politically correct* religious thinking of the day.

On the life issues mentioned above, there are those who began with their own conclusions and have tried to bend theology around their conclusions. This is possible in part because of a lack of a central teaching authority and partly because society has become apathetic to these issues.

This mentality usually results in a lot of division, factions, and schisms.

The Gospel calls *all* believers to embrace the truth, to turn from sin, and to seek holiness and justice...

No matter how hard some may try, a square peg will not fit a round hole.

The camel cannot fit through the eye of the needle... Politically Correct doesn't always work...

Being "Jesus Correct" does!

**Observación:** Parece haber mucha división en algunas iglesias cristianas sobre cuestiones morales, especialmente el aborto, la anticoncepción, la ordenación, y los cuidados al final de la vida.

Si todos los cristianos siguen el Evangelio de Jesús, ¿por qué hay tanta diferencia de opinión?

Respuesta: Siempre hay una lucha entre la cultura y la religión, y parte de esa lucha es la política.

Ser *políticamente correcto* significa que debes abrazar la virtud secular del momento para que seas "*iluminado*", "*sensible*", "*consciente*" y, lo que es más importante, "*de mente abierta*".

Desafortunadamente, el sentido común puede ser sacrificado en la carrera por ser "PC".
