Gospel Meditation:

I recently moved into a new neighborhood. On my first evening I went grocery shopping and could not find my usual favorite Greek yogurt. Strangely, my heart started to race. All the losses of my previous life hit me. So many of my old friends, habits, comforts, and predictable experiences had fallen away. There I stood, a grown man, crying like a little boy whose world was falling apart in the dairy aisle.

This week, Jesus describes what to do when one world ends, and another begins. Does it apply to the end of time? Yes. Does it apply to the end of our individual lives? Yes. It also applies to every "world" we inhabit throughout our lives, in school, family, friendships, work, play and so on. First, the sun, moon, and stars fall. The old, familiar ways of running things suddenly stop working. Light fades. Things fall apart. It's awful. But, second, Christ comes "in the clouds." Jesus, the Son of Man, replaces those old powers with himself as the prime governing principle. Third, he sends out his angels to "gather his elect from the four winds." He re-integrates the fragments into a new integrated whole. "Summer is near," he concludes. A new world begins.

Is your world crumbling? Are your sun, moon, and stars falling from the sky? Learn to discern the pattern of the Cross and Resurrection at work in it. This is the power we touch in the Mass. Jesus is coming precisely in this transition from the old to the new world. It doesn't make our losses easy.

But it does make it possible to glimpse the dawning of a summer, a new beginning, the life of the world to come.

Meditación del Evangelio:

Recientemente me mudé a un nuevo vecindario. En mi primera noche fui de compras al supermercado y no pude encontrar mi yogur griego favorito habitual. Extrañamente, mi corazón comenzó a acelerarse. Todas las pérdidas de mi vida anterior me golpearon. Muchos de mis viejos amigos, hábitos, comodidades y experiencias predecibles se habían desvanecido. Allí estaba yo, un hombre adulto, llorando como un niño pequeño cuyo mundo se estaba cayendo a pedazos en el pasillo de los lácteos.

Esta semana, Jesús describe qué hacer cuando un mundo se acaba y comienza otro. ¿Se aplica al fin de los tiempos? Sí. ¿Se aplica al final de nuestras vidas individuales? Sí. También se aplica a todos los "mundos" que habitamos a lo largo de nuestras vidas, en la escuela, la familia, las amistades, el trabajo, el juego, etc.

Primero, caen el sol, la luna y las estrellas. Las viejas y familiares formas de administrar las cosas de repente dejan de funcionar. La luz se desvanece. Las cosas se desmoronan. Es horrible. Pero, segundo, Cristo viene "en las nubes". Jesús, el Hijo del Hombre, reemplaza esos antiguos poderes por él mismo como el principal principio gobernante. Tercero, envía a sus ángeles a "recoger a sus escogidos de los cuatro vientos". Reintegra los fragmentos en un nuevo todo integrado. "El verano está cerca", concluye. Un nuevo mundo comienza.

¿Tu mundo se está desmoronando? ¿El sol, la luna y las estrellas caen del cielo? Aprendan a discernir el modelo de la Cruz y la Resurrección que actúa en ella. Este es el poder que tocamos en la Misa, Jesús viene precisamente en esta transición del viejo mundo al nuevo. No hace que nuestras pérdidas sean fáciles.

Pero sí permite vislumbrar el amanecer de un verano, un nuevo comienzo, la vida del mundo que viene.

From the Pastor's Desk

Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

Our stewardship catechesis began in September, exploring our sense of belonging to St. Thomas More Catholic Church and School. Belonging inspires us to register, building a strong connection with our parish. In October, we connected this belonging to active participation, praying that God would reveal the gifts we can share with our parish. Last Sunday, we examined the third aspect of stewardship—tithing.

We reflected on the religious significance of tithing through Scripture. The widow who hosted Elijah and the woman who gave her last two cents exemplified trust in God through their giving. Abel's offering of the fatty portion of the firstlings of his flock, the Israelites' offering of their first and best produce to God in Exodus, and the Feast of First Fruits described in Leviticus illustrate that offering our “first” to God sanctifies all that we have, making it a sacred act of gratitude. St. Paul also teaches that Jesus, the “first fruits” of the dead, sanctifies the entire harvest of the resurrection.

The request for increased tithing flows from our gratitude to God and our desire to build His Kingdom here. I am committed to promoting the growth and education our parish offers and to caring for this community, for the glory of God and the sanctification of His people. Increasing our tithing together will help ease the financial challenges we face and allow us to serve more fully. Thank you for considering this call to generosity and trust in God.

Del Escritorio del Pastor

Queridos hermanos y hermanas en Cristo:

Nuestra catequesis sobre la mayordomía comenzó en septiembre, explorando nuestro sentido de pertenencia a la Iglesia y Escuela Católica de St. Thomas More. Este sentido de pertenencia nos inspira a registrarnos y a fortalecer nuestra conexión con la parroquia. En octubre, relacionamos este sentido de pertenencia con la participación activa, pidiendo a Dios que nos revele los dones que podemos ofrecer a nuestra parroquia. El domingo pasado, exploramos el tercer aspecto de la mayordomía: el diezmo.

Reflexionamos sobre el significado religioso del diezmo a través de la Sagrada Escritura. La viuda que hospedó a Elías y la mujer que dio sus últimos dos centavos ejemplifican la confianza en Dios al dar. La ofrenda de Abel de la porción grasa de los primogénitos de su rebaño, las primicias de los israelitas en el libro del Éxodo, y la Fiesta de las Primicias en el libro de Levítico nos enseñan que ofrecer nuestras “primicias” a Dios santifica todo lo que tenemos, convirtiéndolo en un acto sagrado de gratitud. San Pablo también nos enseña que Jesús, “las primicias” de los muertos, santifica toda la cosecha de la resurrección.

Nuestra solicitud de un aumento en el diezmo surge de nuestra gratitud a Dios y nuestro deseo de construir Su Reino aquí. Me comprometo a promover el crecimiento y la educación que nuestra parroquia ofrece y a cuidar de esta comunidad, “para la gloria de Dios y la santificación de Su pueblo.” Al aumentar juntos nuestro diezmo, podremos aliviar las dificultades financieras que enfrentamos y servir de una manera más completa. Les agradezco por considerar este llamado a la generosidad y a la confianza en Dios.


