

Gospel Meditation:

Burnout. Recent studies suggest that roughly two-thirds of doctors and nurses have signs of it. You probably know what burnout is: long-term stress leading to emotional exhaustion and a lack of a sense of personal accomplishment. Burnout can threaten anyone who tries to seriously serve and love others. How does our faith inform this challenging experience, and how do we find refreshment?

The apostles face something like burnout this week in Mark 6. They are run down from their missionary work, and Jesus says, "Come away by yourselves to a lonely place, and rest a while." For them, and for us, it takes humility to intentionally rest. It means the world can go on without us. It stings our pride to admit God is necessary and we are not. Choosing to leave our good work to be with him — whatever the cost — is an act of humble faith. And that trust in God begins to revive us.

But there's more to it. Hilariously, Mark tells us that throngs of needy people find out where the apostles are going and arrive ahead of them. Imagine the exasperation of the burnt-out apostles. "Can we please get a minute to ourselves? This is not healthy!" And Jesus seems to encourage the boundary violation by telling his frayed followers to feed the crowd. Look: once we move into humble rest, he calls us to more work, because we are made for love, not for rest. But Jesus does the vast bulk of the labor. He himself is the one who multiplies the small offering until everyone is satisfied.

What finally gives our heart rest isn't more vacation time.

It's experiencing the super abundant generosity of God for us and those whom we serve.

Meditación del Evangelio:

Burnout. Estudios recientes sugieren que aproximadamente dos tercios de los médicos y enfermeras tienen signos de la enfermedad. Probablemente sepas lo que es el burnout: estrés a largo plazo que conduce al agotamiento emocional y a la falta de un sentido de logro personal. El agotamiento puede amenazar a cualquiera que intente servir y amar seriamente a los demás. ¿Cómo influye nuestra fe en esta experiencia desafiante y cómo encontramos refrigerio?

Los apóstoles se enfrentan a algo parecido al agotamiento esta semana en Marcos 6. Están agotados de su trabajo misionero, y Jesús dice: "Venid vosotros solos a un lugar solitario y descansad un poco". Para ellos, y para nosotros, se necesita humildad para descansar intencionalmente. Significa que el mundo puede seguir sin nosotros. Hiere nuestro orgullo admitir que Dios es necesario y nosotros no lo somos. Elegir dejar nuestra buena obra para estar con él, cueste lo que cueste, es un acto de fe humilde. Y esa confianza en Dios comienza a revivirnos.

Pero hay más. Graciosamente, Marcos nos dice que multitudes de personas necesitadas se enteran de a dónde van los apóstoles y llegan antes que ellos. Imagínese la exasperación de los apóstoles quemados. "¿Podemos, por favor, darnos un minuto para nosotros? ¡Esto no es saludable!" Y Jesús parece alentar la violación de los límites diciéndole a sus seguidores desgastados que alimenten a la multitud. Mira: una vez que entramos en el humilde descanso, él nos llama a trabajar más, porque estamos hechos para el amor, no para el descanso. Pero Jesús hace la mayor parte del trabajo. Él mismo es el que multiplica la pequeña ofrenda hasta que todos estén satisfechos.

Lo que finalmente le da descanso a nuestro corazón no es más tiempo de vacaciones. Es experimentar la generosidad súper abundante de Dios por nosotros y por aquellos a quienes servimos.




